

## University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff CHANCELLOR

The University of Arkansas System President invites applications and nominations for the position of Chancellor of the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff (UAPB). UAPB is part of the University of Arkansas System which enrolls more than 70,000 students, employs over 17,000 employees, and has a total budget of over \$2 billion.

The University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, an 1890 land-grant institution, has been and continues to be the "Flagship of the Delta" and is the second-oldest public university and the only public historically black institution in Arkansas. The institution's historic mission is to teach in areas related to agriculture and the mechanical arts, as well as scientific and classical studies and help solve economic, agricultural and other problems in the community, state and region. It is also home to one of the country's leading programs in aquaculture and fisheries and supports Arkansas's \$165 million aquaculture industry. UAPB is a member-school of the Thurgood Marshall College Fund and ranks among the best colleges and universities in the South according to *U.S. News & World Report* 2012. UAPB offers 33 undergraduate programs, 8 master's programs, and a newly established Ph.D. program in aquaculture/fisheries.

Pine Bluff has a population of approximately 50,000 and serves as the county seat of Jefferson County, Arkansas. A port city on the Arkansas River, Pine Bluff is located less than one hour's drive from Little Rock, Arkansas which is the capital of Arkansas with a combined metropolitan area population of approximately 710,000.

Academic credentials sufficient to engender respect from the academy and the community at large are essential. An earned doctorate or equivalent terminal degree is preferred. The desired leader should have a proven track record for building an accomplished, talented, and diverse senior leadership team. The university seeks a Chancellor who can demonstrate progressively responsible administrative/managerial experience in higher education, experience with strategic planning, enrollment management, service learning, accreditation, program development and fundraising.
